

Keyboard shortcuts

Basics

Switch on your Series 5mx	Esc (<i>On</i>)
Switch off your Series 5mx	Fn + Esc (<i>Off</i>)
Help	Fn + , (<i>Help</i>)
Increase contrast.....	Fn + .
Decrease contrast	Fn + M
Backlight	Fn + Space (<i>Backlight</i>)
Zoom in.....	Ctrl + M
Zoom out.....	Shift + Ctrl + M
Caps lock.....	Fn + Tab (<i>Caps</i>)

General (used in most programs)

Cut	Ctrl + X
Copy.....	Ctrl + C
Paste.....	Ctrl + V
Undo	Ctrl + Z
Redo.....	Ctrl + Y
Bold text	Ctrl + B
Italic text	Ctrl + I
Underline text	Ctrl + U
Set font.....	Shift + Ctrl + F
Insert special character	Shift + Ctrl + C

Moving between programs

Go to last file or open program	Fn + tap System
Display open files and programs.....	Ctrl + tap System
Cycle round open files and programs	Ctrl + Fn + tap System
Open new file in current folder.....	Fn + tap program icon

PC connectivity software

You can connect your Series 5mx to a PC using **PsiWin 2**.

Use PsiWin to:

- Exchange and convert files between your Series 5mx and PC.
- Back up your Series 5mx files to your PC.
- Synchronize your Series 5mx Agenda and Contacts with PC schedulers so that they are kept up to date.
- Print from your Series 5mx via a PC.
- Install programs on your Series 5mx.
- Upgrade Series 3/3a/3c/3mx or Siena files so that you can open them on your Series 5mx.
- Synchronize emails between your Series 5mx and PC.

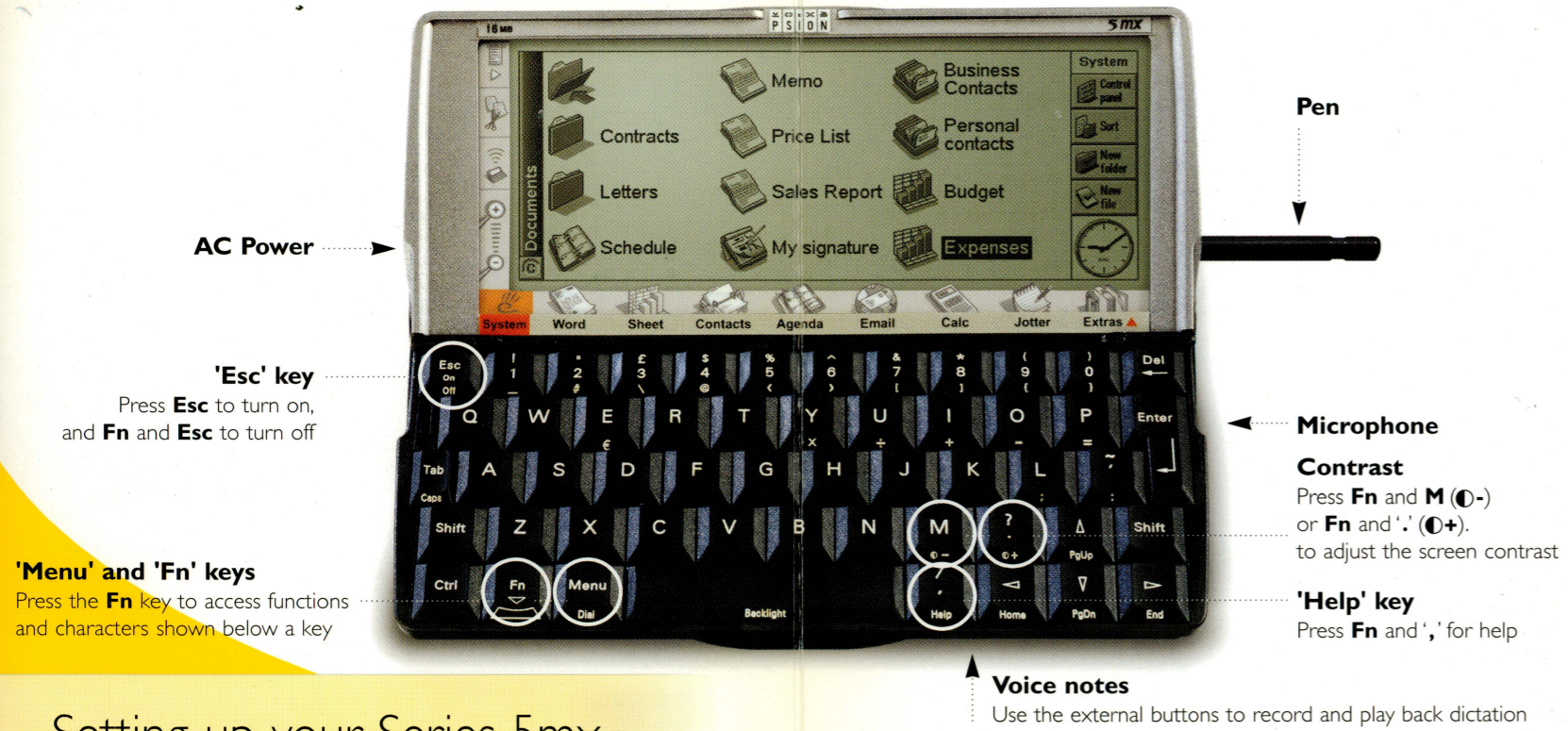

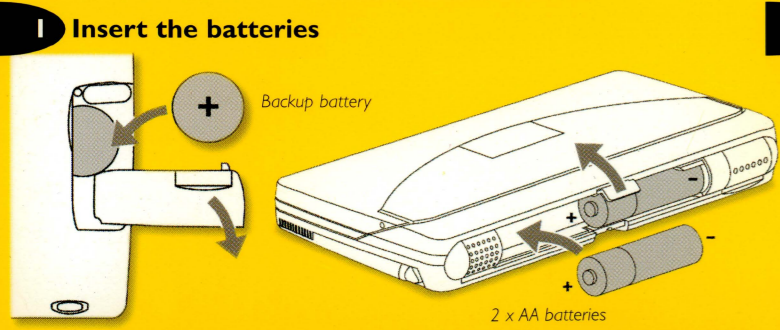
Quick Start Guide



Where things are...



Setting up your Series 5mx



2 Switch on your Series 5mx
Switch on your Series 5mx by pressing **Esc** (switch off by pressing **Fn** and **Esc** together).
Note: Your Series 5mx will take a few seconds to start up the first time you switch it on.

3 Adjust the screen contrast
Press **Fn** and **M** (○-) to reduce the contrast, or press **Fn** and **'.'** (○+) to increase the contrast.

4 Calibrate the screen
Calibrate the screen to improve the accuracy of the pen.
To do this:

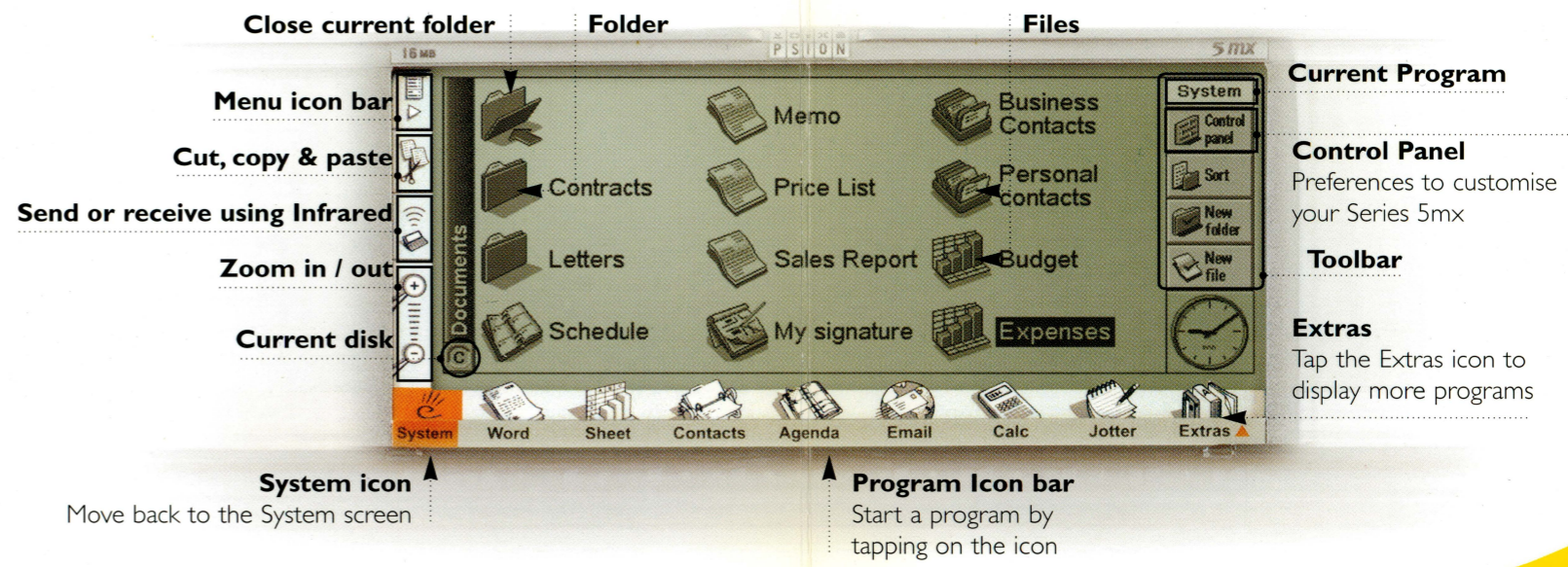
- Tap on the **Control Panel** button from the Toolbar to display the Control Panel.
- Tap on the **Screen** icon twice to display the Screen settings.
- Tap **Calibrate**, and follow the on-screen instructions to calibrate the screen.

5 Set the time & date
To set the time and date:

- Tap on the **Control Panel** button from the Toolbar to display the Control Panel.
- Tap on the **Time & date** icon twice to display the Time settings.
- Tap on the **Time & date** button, then type in the correct time and date and tap **OK**.

Finding your way around

The 'System' screen



You can use the **Control Panel** to change settings on your Series 5mx, e.g.:

- To alter the automatic switch off time.
- To set a password on your Series 5mx.
- To adjust the screen, keyboard or sound settings.

To display the Control Panel, move to the System screen, and tap on the **Control Panel** button on the Toolbar.
