To type the special character, press and release three keys in succession: the Compose key then the two keys of the Compose key sequence.

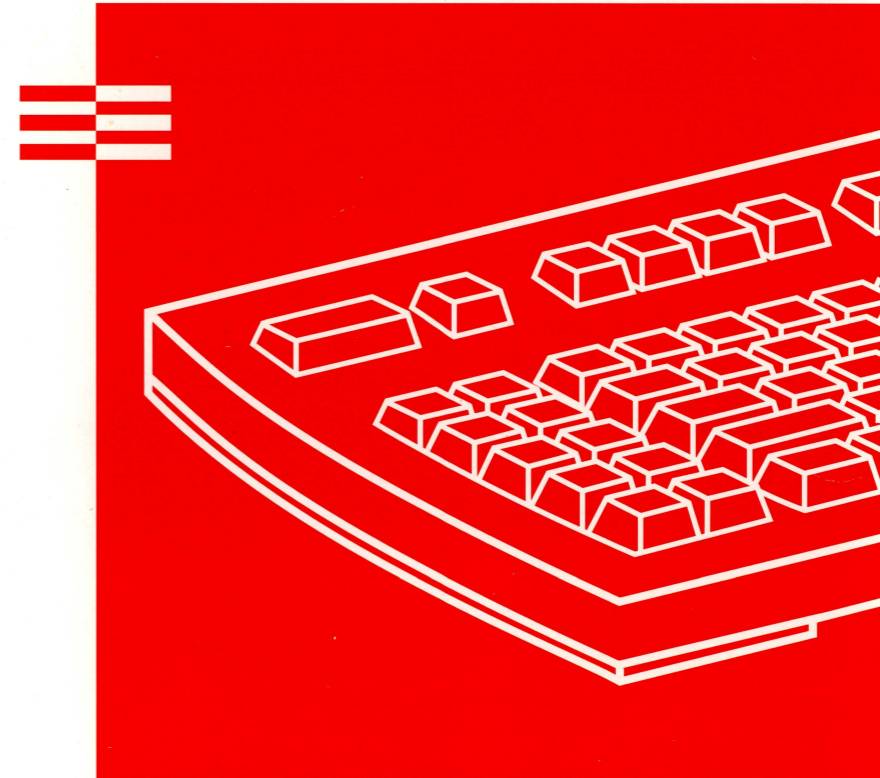

# Sun Type 5c Keyboard—U.S.

**Escape key**—Press and release to change the effect of the next key pressed.

**Application and Function keys and Special keys**—The function of these keys vary with the application. See the documentation for your application for more information.

**Back Space key**—Press to move the insert point to the left and delete the character or selection.

**Audio/Monitor keys**—Press to control speaker volume and monitor brightness and degauss functions.†

**Help key**—Press to display a help window for the object under the mouse pointer.

**Power key**—Press to turn the system power on and off.†

**Left keypad**—Use with window system applications to perform the indicated operations.

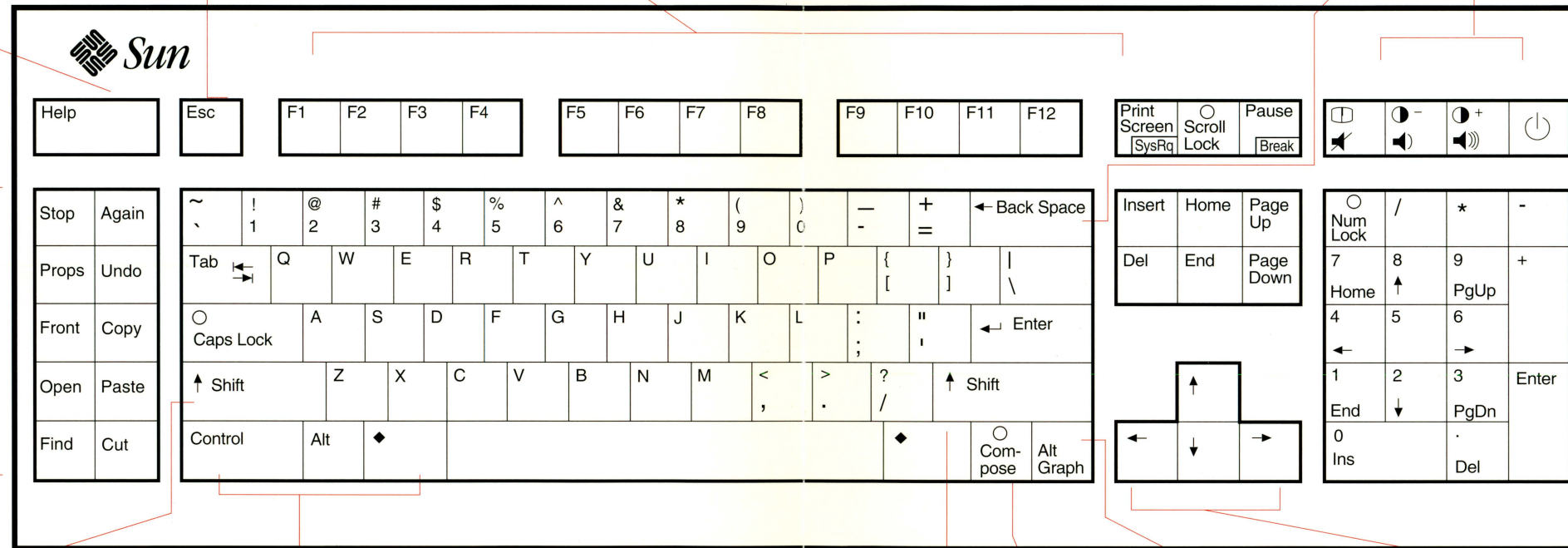
**Numeric keys**—Press the Num Lock key to activate the numeric functions on the right keypad.

**Shift key**—Hold down and press another key to produce uppercase letters or the character that appears on the upper part of the key.

**Control, Alt, Meta keys**—Hold down and press another key for alternate functions.

**Compose key**—Press and then press two other keys to produce the special characters shown in the Compose Key Sequence table on the next page.

**Alt Graph key**—Hold down and press with another key to produce the character that appears on the lower right part of the key. (Not used on U.S. keyboards.)
